



# Sauchie Home Farm

**Our purpose here at Sauchie Home Farm is to offer a relaxing space for rest and renewal and to nurture humans and nature.**

## **Outside**

We have 70 acres of land which has been given over to rewilding, organic fruit and veg growing and tree planting. There's plenty of space to explore and enjoy, including the mature oak wood where you'll find the Sauchie Burn (Willow Stream), a labyrinth for meditative walking and many other walks nearby.

## **Inside**

We offer accommodation on a self-catering basis in the Steading, where there's a spacious lounge/kitchen/dining room, two twin bedrooms and a bathroom. Sofas and a bed settee offer further sleeping. If you can bring your own bed linen/sleeping bags and towels, that would be appreciated, as it cuts down on washing. The kitchen is well equipped with everything you need for cooking with a dish washer and washing machine. You'll find the larder staples like tea, coffee, pasta, herbs, cooking oils etc. There is a bunk room with 2 bunk beds and a potting shed that can sleep 2 people. The large studio can accommodate up to 25 people for workshops or seminars.

For larger groups, and for those who prefer their own room, there is a **Premier Inn M9 J9** 10 minutes by car, which has rooms from £55 per person per night. Remember to select the Premier Inn M9 J9 as there is another Premier Inn in the centre of Stirling.

## **Location and Getting There**

The farm is 10 minutes from the M9/M80 Strling Services and 15 minutes from the train & bus station; directions are below. If you're coming by train or bus, we can usually pick you up. 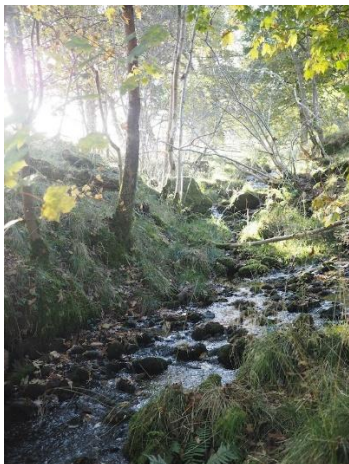
## **Cost**

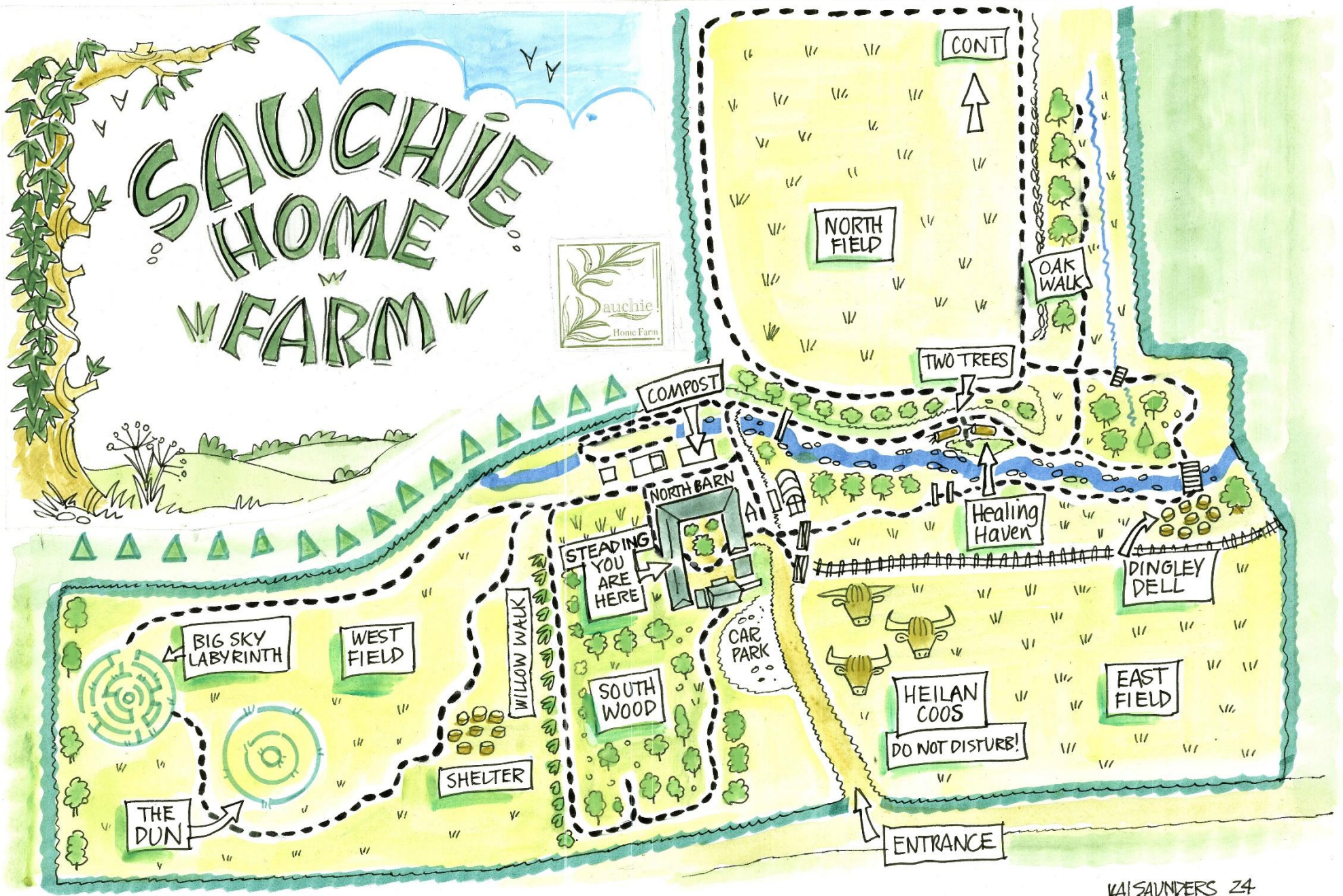

# SAUCHIE HOME FARM



## **Directions for Sauchie Home Farm**

### **From Stirling Railway Station**

- >Follow signs for St Ninians and Bannockburn
- >Continue towards St Ninians and signs for Battle of Bannockburn
- >Immediately After the Battle of Bannockburn Centre take first right, then first left towards Carron Bridge
- >Continue on this road for 2 miles.
- >You will reach a windy downhill part of the road, where you'll see a sign - Carron Bridge 4 miles and a blue fence on your right.
- >Turn right immediately at the blue fence.
- >After 1 minute take first left up a rough track.
- > Go up the track for 3 minutes
- >Sauchie Home Farm is first on the right.

### **From M80/M9 Stirling Services turnoff**

- >Take the Whins of Milton exit
- >Take first left just before The Brewers Fayre
- >At the T Junction turn left
- > Follow road to Carron Bridge for 2 miles
- >You will reach a windy downhill part of the road, where you'll see a sign - Carron Bridge 4 miles and a blue fence on your right.
- >Turn right immediately at the blue fence.
- >After 1 minute take first left up a rough track.
- > Go up the track for 3 minutes
- >Sauchie Home Farm is first on the right.
